



- Extracurricular Activities: Have been involved or are currently involved in extracurricular activities.
- Fields of Study: Engineering, Economics, Political Science, Finance and Management
- Be planning to start their studies in the U.S.A in the year 2022.
- Be committed to coming back to Egypt for two years directly after the successful completion of their bachelor's degree.
- Preference will be given to candidates who have not lived, worked, or studied abroad for a significant period of time.







Country: Germany

Eligibility Criteria:

- To be an Egyptian national residing in Egypt (preference will not be given to dual nationality holders)
- Holder of the ABITUR certificate with highest GPA demonstrating academic excellence (Average grade must be 1.5 or higher)
- Be a recent graduate from one of the German schools in Egypt: DEO, DSB Alexandria, DSB Cairo, and ES in New Cairo
- The scholarships are awarded based on financial need as well as merit and character demonstrated through academic excellence, extracurricular activities, and social behavior
- Scholarships are granted for any field of study except for Medicine
- Satisfy entry requirements for the respective university
- The maximum duration for the scholarship is generally limited to five academic years
- Return to Egypt for three years after graduation

Application Process:

- Interested students fulfilling the selection criteria can apply for the program by filling in a pre-selection application and presenting it to DAAD
- The online application portal for the scholarship's call is available in December of each year. Further information is distributed by the responsible person at the respective German schools
- Students fulfilling all criteria are invited for an interview at the DAAD-Cairo office
 Interview reports are sent with the applications to the DAAD-Bonn office for the final selection
- Selection Committee:

The selection process is implemented through a joint committee of DAAD and Sawiris Foundation along with a panel consisting of DAAD alumni, German university professors, as well as representatives from the German Embassy and the Central Agency for Schools Abroad (ZFA)

Scholarship Benefits:

The SFSD-DAAD scholarship covers tuition fees, educational material, living allowance, travel fees and health insurance



The Executive MSc in Cities is an 18-month master's programme based at the London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE). The programme trains urban leaders and changemakers to understand how cities can be better managed, governed and designed, while equipping them with the skills they need to deliver these changes. Teaching is delivered in a modular format, consisting of five one-week residential sessions in London where participants are exposed to the latest analysis, strategy and delivery tools to address urgent issues of urban inequality, economic development and environmental sustainability. Participants are not required to be resident in London outside of teaching modules, allowing them to continue working while studying.

The LSE-Sawiris Scholarships provides support for urban practitioners working in the public and third (non-profit) sectors who are passionate about achieving positive change in Egyptian cities. All applicants are expected to demonstrate that they are actively working in an urban-related role and are dedicated to making a visible impact in their field. Applications are particularly welcome from those working in government (local or national) or small, grassroots charities that aim to improve the wellbeing of their community.

Teaching Method: Classroom, Leadership Development Program, Site and Organization Visits, and Distance Learning.

Fields of Study: Executive MSc in Cities

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants must be Egyptian nationals residing in Egypt (preference will not be given to dual nationality holders).
- Applicants must be primarily employed by an Egyptian governmental organisation (local or national)
 or a non-profit organisation (outside of academia) that works to improve the wellbeing of people in
 Egypt. Employees of local / grassroots non-profit organisations are especially encouraged to apply.
- Applicants should have a minimum of ten years of professional experience, ideally in an urban-related field.
- Applicants should have a good first degree, equivalent to a UK 2:1 or higher or equivalent professional qualification. Equivalent to 80% or higher from an Egyptian University.
- Applicants will need to demonstrate English language proficiency. Details of how this can be demonstrated are available on the LSE website (the 'higher' level is required).
- Applicants will need to demonstrate a commitment to work in Egypt for two consecutive years after completing the program.
- Please note that employees of private sector organisations are not eligible to apply, even if their company is contracted for work by a public sector or non-profit organisation.



SFSD - DAAD Scholarship Program

- Holder of the ABITUR certificate with highest GPA demonstrating academic excellence (Average grade must be 1.5 or higher)
- Be a recent graduate from one of the German schools in Egypt: DEO, DSB Alexandria, DSB Cairo, and ES in New Cairo
- The scholarships are awarded based on financial need as well as merit and character demonstrated through academic excellence, extracurricular activities, and social behavior
- Scholarships are granted for any field of study except for Medicine
- Satisfy entry requirements for the respective university
- The maximum duration for the scholarship is generally limited to five academic years
- Return to Egypt for three years after graduation

The selection process is implemented through a joint committee of DAAD and Sawiris Foundation along with a panel consisting of DAAD alumni, German university professors, as well as representatives from the German Embassy and the Central Agency for Schools Abroad (ZFA)

2. GRADUATE PROGRAMS

Gouna Technical Nursing Institute Scholarship Program

The Gouna Technical Nursing Institute (GTNI) was established by the Sawiris Foundation for Social Development in November 2009, in collaboration with Lawrence Memorial / Regis College in the USA. The GTNI aims to become a leading center in the field of nursing in the region. It offers a two-and-a-half-year degree in nursing in addition to 3 months of internship, under the supervision of Egypt's Ministry of Higher Education. The academic system in the GTNI is fully in English with the availability of an intensive English proficiency course in the preparatory semester.

- Candidates should contact the GTNI Student Affairs Office, which is authorized to provide information about: personal interviews and pre-test dates, as well as the list of required documents.

Direct Enrollment:

- Candidates who are already enrolled in colleges and wish to transfer to GTNI should apply directly to GTNI by contacting the Student Affairs Office.
- Interested candidates should also be holders of a high school certificate (Science Section) & provide transcripts of their high school and the higher education institutions in which they are enrolled.

Admission and Enrollment Committee:

The committee consists of GTNI's Dean, Head of Academic and Student Affairs department, assigned Faculty members and teachers, and Student Affairs Officer

Scholarship Benefits:






The German Hotel School in Gouna Scholarship Program






